
Link Stitch (Unsupported)



Sewing Pattern

This pattern is for a four-hole, multiple signature, unsupported text. Beginning at the left, enter the signature and go to the first hole, then out and into the 2nd signature, then out at the third hole and back into the first signature, then out at the the end. Next enter the second signature at the end, go to the third hole, out and into the first signature, out at the second hole, back into the 2nd signature and out at the first hole. Pull thread tightly and tie knot.

Next enter the third signature, go to the second hole, exit and go between the first two signatures and back into the same hole. Always place the needle between the signatures ahead of the previous loop in the direction of travel. When you get to the end, loop between the signatures (kettle stitch) and enter the fourth signature...

Continue until book is completed. To secure thread, make two kettle stitches, snip ends of thread, and glue to spine, smoothing between signatures to reduce bulk.
